FATAL 48 Hours

In Sydney alone, Paramedics have responded to over **100** motor vehicle crashes in the past 48 hours.

There has been rollovers, persons trapped, fatalities, pedestrians knocked down, motor cycles hit by cars.

Ambulance would like to remind the community that during wet weather, drivers should take extra care on the roads as these conditions result in reduced visibility, flooding and slippery road surfaces which make driving particularly hazardous.

We would also like to remind drivers that they need to take extra care around school zones and also when passing school buses that are picking up & dropping off children.

For your own safety and the safety of other road users, drivers need to adjust their driving behaviour to suit these changing conditions.
