

NSW Ambulance teddies pattern

Directions 8 Ply Wool (No Angora)

Use No. 9 or No. 10 needles
(Metric sizes 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ or 3 $\frac{1}{4}$)
(Loose knitters use No 10. needles)

8 ply wool at least 3 colours – one main colour for face, hands and legs, one colour for the trousers/shorts (pants) and one for the jumper.

Legs and Pants

Cast on 12 stitches (leg)
Knit 34 rows
Change colour wool for pants
Knit 8 rows
Knit another leg to match
Join by knitting across both legs
Knit 14 rows in the same wool as the pants (this finishes the pants).

Shirt (change colour wool)

Knit 18 rows

Sleeve

Cast on 12 stitches on each side of knitting
Knit 18 rows
Cast off 12 stitches each end (this forms the arms)

Head

Change colour wool to that of the legs
Knit 34 rows

Repeat this procedure to obtain the other side of the teddy then continue as below.

Cast off

Sew on face
Join up
Fill with soft filling
Gather around base of head to form neck
Ears – Stitch through the corner of each side of the head to form a small triangle which is the ear
