Emergency scenarios activity

In emergencies NSW Ambulance cares for injured and sick people before taking them to hospital.

In emergencies the NSW Police Force prevent crime and make sure everyone stays safe including road safety.

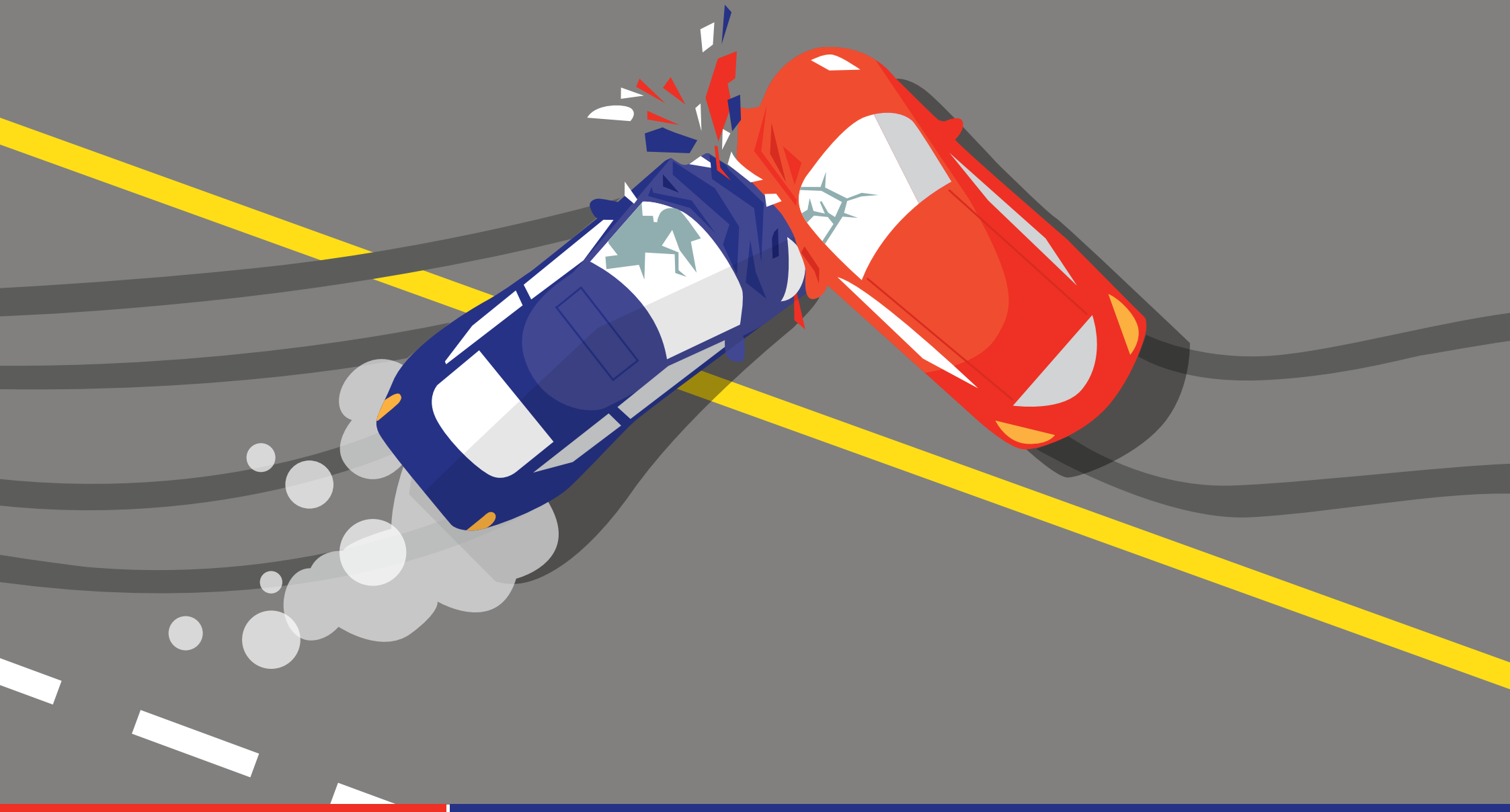
In emergencies Fire and Rescue NSW keep people safe from hazards, this includes putting out fires and helping people trapped in cars after a car crash.

Make sure you have your ambulance, police car and fire engine built and ready to go!

Using your emergency vehicles, allocate the emergency service that should be called to each of the eight emergency scenarios.

Teacher/ parent/ guardian instructions:

1. For each scenario ask why the child allocated that emergency service and provide feedback.
2. Reassure the child that they only need to call once, the call-taker will organise other emergency services to attend if required.
3. Come up with other emergency scenarios to quiz the child and see how they go allocating emergency services.

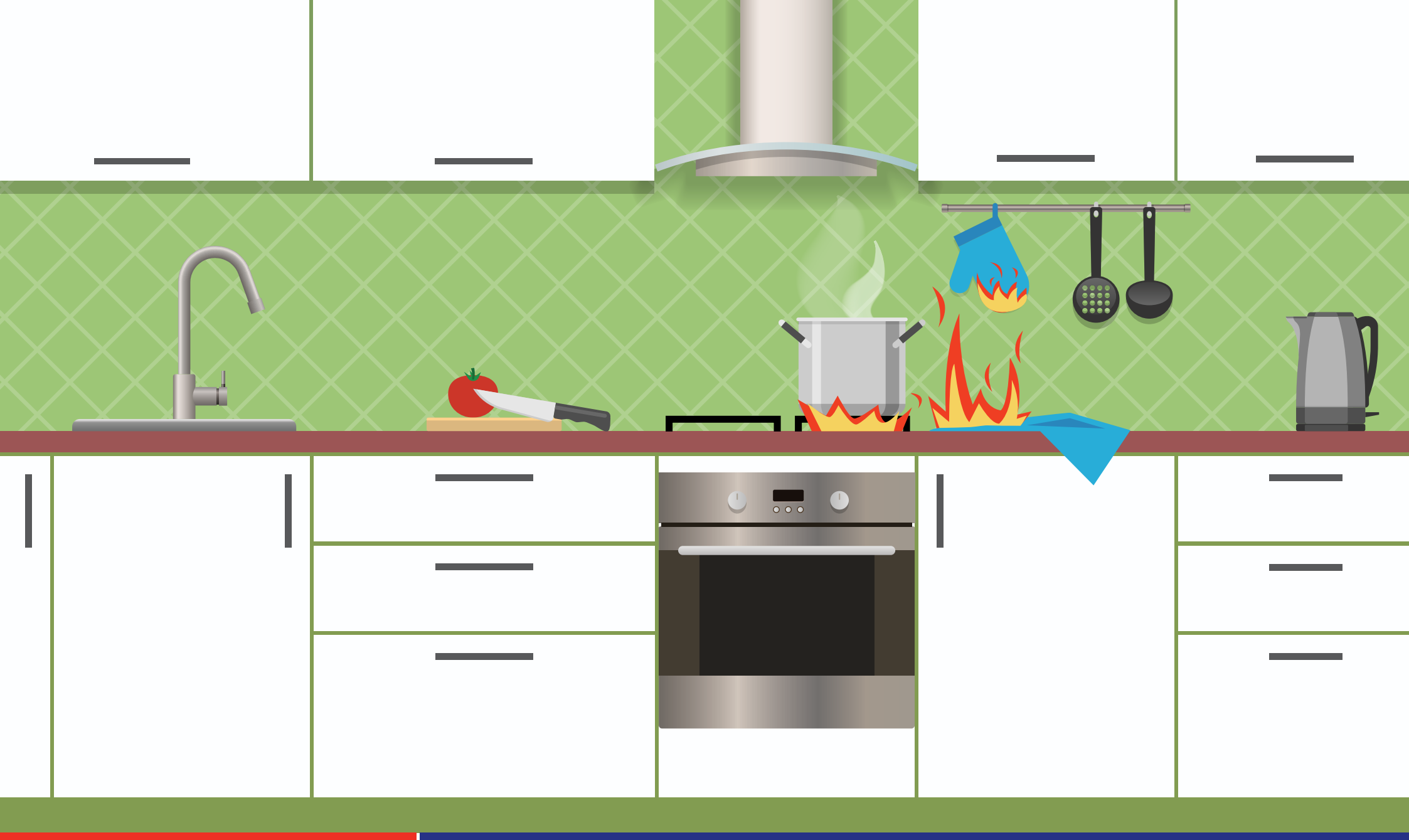
