

## NSW Ambulance Priority Codes

Calls to NSW Ambulance via Triple Zero (000) are triaged using the Medical Priority Dispatch System (MPDS). NSW Ambulance cases are prioritised at the time an ambulance is requested.

- Priority 1 cases are those determined as the highest priority and represent potentially life-threatening cases requiring an immediate ambulance response under lights and siren.
- Priority 2 cases are those requiring an ambulance response in a timeframe appropriate to the condition of the patient without warning devices, or a referral to Healthdirect Australia for secondary medical assessment and advice.
